Important to know...

- The **SCHOOL TAX RATE** is set by the school district.
- APPRAISAL VALUES are set by the COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT.
- Valley Mills ISD has one of the lowest tax rates in the McLennan County area.
- Valley Mills ISD's total tax rate has declined 34.7% since 2019.



EXEMPTION FOR RESIDENTS 65+

The proposed bonds will not impact taxes on homes of senior citizens with a 65+/ disabled exemption on their homesteads. (Improvements to a homestead can increase the taxes.)



ESTIMATED TAX IMPACT TO HOMEOWNER

This chart estimates the maximum projected annual tax impact on the appraised market value of a homestead only, including the proposed state-mandated homestead exemption of \$140,000*
